I would like to convey to you the message of the GC in this regard:

**“Seek Peace and Pursue It:  
In solidarity with our Brothers and Sisters in Thailand for Peace”**

The Christian Conference of Asia (CCA), an ecumenical body composed of 101 member churches and 17 national councils across 21 countries in Asia, through its general committee, expresses deep concern over the current impasse occurring in Thailand. Our deep concern is mainly on the deterioration of peaceful demonstrations into violent confrontation, which has caused the lives of many innocent people including children.

The CCA General Committee along with our member churches and councils, assure the churches and people of Thailand of our prayers for peace in this country. We believe that through dialogue, reconciliation can be fostered as a way out of this impasse.

We are edified by the efforts to mediate for peace and reconciliation. It is our hope that our brothers and sisters in the Church of Christ in Thailand will contribute to the peacemaking process. Let God's love lead the people of Thailand to justice and peace.

In the name of Christ, our peace, we commend the people of Thailand to the guidance and keeping of the one who created us all.
