Taizé prayer originates from a small town in the South of France, where Christian brothers of all denominations have gathered to reflect in word, song, silence and prayer. The style of prayer has attracted thousands of youths from across the world over the years, as it is inter-denominational and focuses on finding a personal connection with God through the daily prayers, silent reflection and Bible study sharing groups.
